EXCURSION

Nature outing in the heart of the Forêt d'Orient Regional Natural Park

Distance: 11 km

Availability: Year-round

From 77€* per person – transport not included

➤ On a wild, 50-hectare peninsula on the shores of **Lake Orient**, the **Wildlife Area** offers a discreet encounter with deer, Przewalski's horses, bison, and elk roaming semi-freely. Here, there are no display cases or walls: you observe, you listen, you wait...

➤ **After lunch overlooking the lake**, your nature guide will take you on a **sensory walk through the ever-changing landscapes of the Forêt d'Orient Regional Natural Park**. Between meadows, ponds, and undergrowth, depending on the season, you'll listen for birds, search for orchids, and/or the signs of the European wildcat.



SHORT STAY

Nature and thrills at Nigloland Amusement Park and 4-star hotels

2 days / 1 night

Distance: The entire program is based at Nigloland

Validity: From April to November, according to the park's opening schedule

From 173€* per person

*Price based on 3 paying guests sharing a room during the off-season, instead of €238 per person.



Day 1

Upon your arrival in the early evening, head to **Erizo**, the park's new restaurant: gourmet buffets, fresh seasonal produce, and creative local cuisine!

Spend the night at one of the park's **two four-star hotels**: the **Cabaïana suites** on stilts, nestled in a lush garden, or the **immersive and intimate atmosphere of the Hôtel des Pirates**.

Day 2

The next day, adventure and thrills await: **Nigloland** is the only French amusement park with the «Sustainable Entertainment» label. Six themed areas to explore, in a **stunning 40-hectare natural setting**, with centuries-old trees, meadows, and a river as a backdrop.





SHORT STAY

Wandering through parks and gardens

3 days / 2 nights

Distance: 223 km

Validity: Monday to Friday, May to October

Day 1

We begin our journey in style at the **Château de La Motte-Tilly**, with its 60-hectare park designated a «Remarkable Garden.» After a lunch featuring local flavours, we head to the botanical garden of **Marnay-sur-Seine**: a haven teeming with wild, vegetable, medicinal, and aromatic plants. Finish with a stroll through **the medieval gardens of Troyes**, in the heart of its uniquely charming historic center. Dinner and overnight stay at your 3-star hotel.

Day 2

The morning begins in **Chaource** with a visit to its church and its striking Entombment of Christ, followed by a stop at the last remaining **artisanal cheese dairy in the Aube region**—with a tasting, of course! After lunch, a stroll through the **Priory gardens**, then a **drive to Les Riceys** to discover its vineyards, traditional stone huts (cadoles), taste its **Rosé des Riceys wine**, and admire its château with its park and formal gardens. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 3

A final day immersed in nature in **the Forêt d'Orient Regional Natural Park**, visiting **the Dosches windmill** and its gardens to discover heritage plants. Lunch at a **country restaurant** where the flower garden invites you to stroll. And to conclude this journey, stop by **the half-timbered church of Longsols**, one of the seven gems of this unique heritage.

SHORT STAY

7 Days of Nature and Hiking

Duration : 7 days / 6 nights

Distance: 295 km

Validity: February to November

From 693€* per person – transport not included

Day 1

We start in **Troyes**, taking the time to explore its historic centre and visit the **Cité du Vitrail** (Stained Glass Museum), a jewel of light and color. In the evening, check into your accommodation, very close to **Lake Orient**.

Day 2

We gain some altitude at **the Dosches windmill** before lunch by the water. In the afternoon, we begin our hike with two loop trails, punctuated by a visit to **the Maison du Parc (Park House)**, in the heart of the **Forêt d'Orient Regional Natural Park**.

Day 3

We head to **Dienville** to discover its church and harbour, and enjoy lunch with a view. In the afternoon, we hike around the lake for a breath of fresh air.

Day 4

In the morning, we visit the **Brienne-la-Vieille Ecomuseum**, a testament to rural life of yesteryear. Then, we hike through the surrounding landscape, with a picnic lunch along the way.

Day 5

A morning hike, lunch, then a self-guided visit to **the Wildlife Area of the Forêt d'Orient**, where deer, Przewalski's horses, bison, and moose roam semi-freely.

Day 6

A morning walk, a well-deserved lunch, followed by a visit to **the half-timbered church in Chauffour-lès-Bailly**. The day concludes with a final hike in the heart of nature.

Day 7

Next stop: **the Côte des Bar** for a hike through the vineyards, followed by a cellar tour and champagne tasting. The trip ends on a high note with a convivial lunch and a visit to **the Cistercian abbey of Clairvaux**.
