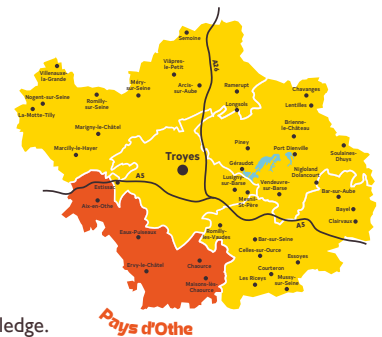
Nature and local expertise in the Pays d'Othe region

Distance: 12.3 km

Availability: all year round

- Head to the Pays d'Othe for a day that connects eras and knowledge. High above Aix-en-Othe, **the organic farm of Mont Saint-Benoit** welcomes you: nestled among meadows, fields, and apple orchards, the **Gauffard family raises a joyful diversity of animals** while respecting the natural balance.
- At table, a change of pace awaits: **savour a medieval-inspired lunch** before continuing with a visit to **the collegiate church of Villemaur-sur-Vanne**, a jewel of local heritage. It houses one of the last remaining carved wooden rood screens in France.
- The afternoon continues in the heart of **the orchards of the Pays d'Othe**. Discover the tradition of local cider and juices, ratafias, and other homemade specialties.

Cleaning service in Troyes

Distance: 7.5 km

Availability: All year round

- Immerse yourself in **Troyes, in its historic centre shaped like a champagne cork!** Between medieval alleyways, half-timbered houses, and reminders of the great fairs of yesteryear, the city reveals a vibrant and welcoming heritage. After your visit, head to **the Cellier Saint-Pierre, a distillery located at the foot of the cathedral**: the perfect opportunity to discover **the famous Prunelle de Troyes**... and to taste it, of course!
- After a pleasant lunch, the scenery changes in Barberey-Saint-Sulpice: **we embark on a canoe trip with a twist**. Equipped with gloves and bags, you participate in a community initiative: **cleaning the banks of the Seine** while enjoying a moment on the water. A worthwhile... and joyful gesture!

Following in the footsteps of Camille Claudel... To the rhythm of the accordion

Distance: 17.7 km

Availability: May to September

✦ In Nogent-sur-Seine, the **Camille Claudel Museum** invites you to discover the life of this extraordinary artist. After the museum, understand the context in which she developed and made her mark by **visiting the town** where she met **Alfred Boucher**, her first mentor, in 1874.

✦ After a lunch featuring local flavours, it's **time for a festive interlude at the Guinguette du Passage** in Romilly-sur-Seine. Under the wrought-iron arbors, you'll rediscover the atmosphere of yesteryear... and the pleasure of dancing at the water's edge.

Workshop Secrets and Traditions

Duration : 2 days / 1 night

Day 1 Enter the world of **Tuilerie Poterie Royer**, a family business awarded the Entreprise du Patrimoine Vivant label. For six generations, the Royer family has been transforming local clay into tiles, bricks and pottery, fired in an impressive 100 m³ wood-fired kiln, **using traditional techniques**.

After a traditional lunch, discover the **Écomusée de la Forêt d'Orient** (Orient Forest Ecomuseum). This vibrant museum recounts three centuries of rural life through everyday trades and objects. A wonderful way to rediscover the skills of yesteryear.

The afternoon continues behind the scenes at the **Théâtre Équestre de Champagne** (Champagne Equestrian Theatre) for a special tour of this unique venue. Then, enjoy dinner at your leisure in the open-air café before attending **the indoor equestrian show**.

Overnight stay in a 3-star hotel.

Day 2 Immerse yourself in **the workshop of Dess Umbrellas and Parasols**, a French manufacturer since 1978. You'll discover the creation process of these handcrafted pieces, a blend of tradition and quality.

After lunch, explore local heritage with a visit to **a stunning half-timbered church in Longsols**. The day concludes at **the Moulin de Dosches and its community garden**, a place dedicated to environmental sustainability and the transmission of lost skills.
