Discover Troyes with rhythm

- The day begins with an introduction to Segway riding through the narrow streets of the historic centre, wind in your hair. After this unique outing, it's time for some free time at the Halles market: andouillette, Chaource, champagne, sweets from Maison Caffet (Best Craftsman of France). Hard not to indulge.
- In the afternoon, the pace changes: head to the canals to discover **Troyes from the water**, this time by canoe. Another perspective on the city, whilst gliding peacefully.

Stained glass and window shopping in Troyes

Mileage: the entire program is based in Troyes. Validité : All year round

- Heading to Troyes, the historic capital of Champagne. During a guided tour, one strolls among colourful half-timbered houses, cobbled streets, and churches filled with spectacular stained-glass windows.
- The walk continues at the foot of the Cathedral, at the Cellier Saint-Pierre for a visit to its distillery and a tasting of the famous **Prunelle de Troyes** (whose secret is well kept!).
- After a lunch of local products, the mood changes: head to **the shops at the McArthurGlen Troyes centre.** With your «Fashion Passport» in hand, enjoy great deals with additional discounts at more than 100 major brands.












EXCURSION

Time travel from Bar-sur-Aube to Colombey-les-deux-Églises

Distance: 16 km
Validity: All year round
From 74€*per person – transport not included

After a lunch featuring local flavours, head to **Colombey-les-Deux-Églises.** The Charles de Gaulle Memorial takes you on an immersive journey through the major events of the 20th century, as seen through the life of the General. The visit continues at **La Boisserie, the family home of Charles de Gaulle**, a place steeped in history.

The day begins in colour with **the City of Stained Glass**, where ancient masterpieces or contemporary creations can be admired at eye level.

Right next door, the **Cellier Saint-Pierre** opens its doors to you: a distillery discreetly nestled at the foot of the cathedral. After the visit, it's time to taste the famous **Prunelle liqueur**.

Lunch with local flavours, followed by a guided tour of **Troyes**, the historical capital of Champagne. You will discover its cobbled streets, its colourful half-timbered houses, and its many churches with remarkable stained glass windows.

Free time then allows you to explore at your own pace: a gourmet stroll at the **Halles market** or a stop at the **Taverne des Compagnons** to taste beer or mead, like stepping back into the medieval era.

Dinner and overnight stay in a 3-star hotel in the heart of Troyes.

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In the morning, head to **the Museum of the Renaissance in Champagne**, then **the Museum of Knitting**, to delve into the industrial and textile history of the city.

After a convivial lunch in the city centre, you finish your getaway with an astonishing place: **the House of Tools and Worker Memories**, with its exceptional collection of 12,000 period tools dedicated to manual craftsmanship. A final nod to the intelligence of the hand and the savoir-faire of the people of Aube.
